

New Adult Only Outdoor Pool Coming To Cincinnati Sports Club Construction Begins This September

Cincinnati Sports Club, now in its 29th year of serving Cincinnati's eastside, will soon be constructing a 2,000 square foot Adult Only Outdoor Pool, (for those 21 years of age and older), including a Poolside bar and Poolside café. This new pool will be the 6th aquatic facility for Cincinnati Sports Club, more than any other club in the region. Pool construction is expected to begin at the conclusion of the outdoor pool season in September 2019, with anticipated completion at the start of the summer pool season in May 2020.

Says Cincinnati Sports Club Club Manager Heather Luttrull, "The new Adult Only Outdoor Pool is a continuation of the ongoing implementation of the Club's long-term master plan, known as Club Vision 2025, as we strive to make continual improvements for our members. The new pool will enhance our summer aquatic experience for adults, and its many unique features include: a new poolside bar and café, lounge pool with steps, shaded privacy cabanas, water fall and an Adult Only whirlpool. It truly will be an oasis for adults looking for a bit of relaxation or a summer staycation."

She continues, "The configuration of the new adult only outdoor pool will give the Club more flexibility in extending the hours of operation and the seasonal usage of the new pool for our adult members. Lap swimmers will be able to enjoy morning or evening outdoor workouts. Additionally, we are hopeful to expand beyond the traditional summer pool months to reach the shoulder seasons of spring and fall."

BUILDING DEPARTMENT CHANGES



The Village now contracts with the Hamilton County Building Department and no longer issues permits in-house with the retirement of Building Official John Hester in December 2018. Residential and commercial properties, are however, required to obtain a Zoning Certificate from the Village of Fairfax for most projects BEFORE submitting a permit application to Hamilton County

For all new projects including new construction, additions, roofs, HVAC, building alterations, demolitions, construction of decks, etc. a zoning application must be filled out and submitted to Mr. Telgkamp. The zoning application is available online at www.fairfaxoh.com or a form can be picked up from the municipal building or requested from the Zoning Official at dtelgkamp@fairfaxoh.org.

Once a zoning certificate is issued, to apply for a building permit, go to www.hamitoncounty.gov/government/departments/buidlings and inspections. There you can download permit applications, schedule an inspection or contact the Building Department for building code related questions. All building permit fees are now payable to Hamilton County before the issuance of a permit.

There are some items that do not require a building permit, but just need zoning approval. Examples are fences and sheds of a certain size. The Zoning Official can inform you of what items need just zoning approval and which require both zoning approval and a building permit from Hamilton County.
