FAIRFAX INCOME TAX FILING DEADLINE JULY 15, 2020

All residents and businesses are required to file their 2019 income tax with the Village of Fairfax by July 15, 2020. Please contact Tax Clerk Amanda Jostworth at 513-527-6506 or ajostworth@fairfaxoh.org if you have any questions or need assistance with filing. Due to COVID-19 we would like to avoid in-person tax filing as much as possible. Amanda is still available to assist in the preparation of residential tax forms for anyone needing assistance. Tax forms, W2's and other tax documents can continue to be placed in the secure drop box available outside of the front doors of the municipal building. Or, forms can be personally handed in to the police department during regular business hours – 9:00 AM – 5:00 PM Monday-Friday. Please place your forms in a sealed envelope with you name and address.

Non-emergency issues with the police department or citation payouts can be made in person at the Fairfax Police station. The police department foyer has remained open to the public and payouts can be made with the Police Clerk with social distancing already in place.

For anyone interested in home improvements, please contact Tony Perkins, Zoning Officer at tperkins@fairfaxoh.org or 513-702-9432. You must obtain a zoning certificate for any kind of work you may want to do to your home including fencing, roofing, sheds, adding doors/windows, room additions, and HVAC work to name a few. Most work, except for fencing and small sheds also require a building permit from Hamilton County. Mr. Perkins can assist residents through the process.

For all other business, you may use the drop box in front of the municipal building or contact either the Fiscal Officer at 527-6505 or Administrator at 527-6503 during regular business hours Monday-Friday.

2020 RESIDENTIAL STREET PROGRAM

The JK Meurer Construction Company has been awarded the contract for the 2020 residential street construction project. This work will begin shortly after July 4, 2020. Streets that will have road and/or curb replacement: Arrow Point Way, Eleanor Street, and the dead-end portion of High Street. The intersection of Wooster Road/Red Bank Road will also receive asphalt repairs and new striping. Notices to residents have been provided, but more specific notices will be given out by the contractor. If you are a resident on any of these streets, please be aware that no parking signs during construction will be posted. Please make plans now on where to store your vehicle if you cannot place it in a driveway.
