Happy New Year to all of our residents and businesses! The Village Maintenance Department is prepared for potential snow and ice this year and will be out to plow and salt the streets when needed. For residents that may park on the street – we ask that you park in your driveway whenever possible when snow/ice is in the forecast. Our narrow streets can be difficult to maneuver with the larger trucks and plows. Less cars on the streets also makes for a much cleaner street after a snowfall.

Also, any residents that may have portable basketball hoops, we ask that you remove them from the planter strip/curb area as soon as possible. These will interfere with the efficient and safe removal of snow from your streets. The Village Maintenance Department may tag any portable hoops they deem an impediment to the safe removal of snow and ice from the streets. Thank you in advance for your cooperation. May all of you have a great 2020!!

A reminder for any residents that have not done so already – when you turn your water off to your outside water spigots, remember to remove your hoses as well. Freezing water that is in the hose line can cause issues to your home. As you remove the leaves from your yard, remember to check your gutters one last time as well so that freezing water that could damage your gutters and downspouts gets stuck in them.
