2020 ELECTION INFORMATION

The Village of Fairfax will have in-person election at the Fairfax Recreation Center precinct on Hawthorne Ave. for all Fairfax registered voters. Anyone who has any questions about voting should contact the Hamilton County Board of Elections at https://votehamiltoncountyohio.gov or 513-632-7000 M-F 8AM – 4PM. Voting will be on Tuesday November 3, 2020 from 6:30 AM – 7:30 PM. Pelease be sure to wear a mask. All voters must bring an acceptable form of ID. Examples of acceptable photo documents: An Ohio issued driver's license, State of Ohio or Federal government ID. Or, you can bring an Acceptable ID document: utility bill, bank statement, payroll check — any of these documents must show your name and current address and be dated within 12 months.

A voter presenting an ID that shows the voter's former address is permitted to cast a regular ballot so long as the voter's current address has been updated with the Board of Elections and appears in the official poll list for that precent.

Voters who do not provide any ONE of these documents at the precinct will still be able to vote using a provisional ballot and providing the last 4 digits of their social security number or appearing at the Board of Elections office within 7 days of Election Day to provide ID.

We ask that those residents who wish to take extra caution and who do not wish to pass out candy to keep their porch light off and door closed between the hours of 6-8 PM. For those families that may be out with their Trick or Treaters, please only look for homes with porch lights on and which appear to be open for visitors.

Mask wearing by both Trick or Treaters, their parents/guardians and those passing out candy should be worn when within 6 feet of another. For parents, it is advised to wipe down candy wrappers after your children return home before eating any candy. Everyone – please avoid any home-made treats made by strangers. If you or your child are at greater risk of complications from COVID-19, please contact your doctor before considering participating in Halloween activities.

The Fairfax police department will be on patrol. Please advise any children to pay attention to crossing at crosswalks, especially on the more heavily traveled roads such as Watterson. We wish you and your families a very safe and Happy Halloween!
