## **TAX RETURN FILING**

The filing of Village of Fairfax local income tax returns has been extended to May 15, 2020. Walk-in taxpayer service has been suspended, but drop off tax return preparation is still available. Please email, email or fax your returns. You may also use the drop box on the side of the municipal (go to drive between the municipal building and rec center) or take your returns to the Police Department window inside the Police Department entry door at the front of the building. In the near future, we will have a drop box at the entrance to the municipal building.

When dropping off your information, please provide copies (if applicable) of your:

- W-2s (be sure to include the version that shows taxes paid to other cities, if any, in Box 18)
- Schedule C
- Schedule E
- 1099 Misc.

## **EMERGENCY NOTIFICATIONS**

Residents are encouraged to sign up for the Village's IRIS (Immediate Rapid Information System) Communicator that provides automated phone, text and/or email updates from the Village including weather related/flash flooding warnings, public health information such as COVID-19 updates, and other local information. Both land lines and cell phone numbers may be included. You can also indicate whether you would like to receive only emergency notifications or non-emergency announcements as well.
